

Can an electrical box be installed on a door frame



Overview

A panel cannot be installed where a door, when fully opened, swings into and blocks this required 36-inch deep working area. If the door swing encroaches upon the minimum depth, it constitutes a non-compliant obstruction that prevents safe access and maintenance. If your box is TOO CLOSE to certain devices, it will be hard to put on the cover plate, and make the install look good. We use Electrical Scabs to nudge our box over. For the sake of brevity, The National Electrical Code outlines that a breaker box must be installed in an area that provides clearance around. There must be 3 feet of clearance in front of your electrical panels, and the door must be able to open at least 90 degrees. Move any boxes or objects that obstruct your view.
